Information in SkyCalls

Load	30min	15min	Take off
HERCULES / 2	22:00	22:15	22:30

This utility shows loads from **SkyWin** having status **Planned** or **Booked** for the current day, ordered by load time.

Load which already has taken off is displayed in gray with aircraft and load number strikethrough.

Every row represents a load. Aircraft and load number displayed within parenthesis means this is a load who took off, but the jumpers never jumped but rather landed in the aircraft.

For every load there will be 3 different times, one for the 30-minute call, one for the 15-minute call and one for take off time.

The background color of times for 15- and 30-minute call have these meanings:

- Normal background (typical *white*) – no call has been done
- *Red* background – a call should have been done, but hasn't
- *Light green* background – a call has been done

The user can mark that a call has been done in two different ways. One way is to answer Yes to a question which pops up automatically when it's time for a call. Then the background color will shift to reflect this. The other way is to toggle call on/off by double-clicking on the desired time.

The title of **SkyCalls** is complemented with a timer counting down the time to next call, thus giving the user a quick way to see how much time there is left.
